

## Alone

Exodus 24:2 And Moses **alone** shall come near the LORD (God), but they shall not come near; nor shall the people go up with him.”

Deuteronomy 29:14 “I make this covenant and this oath, not with you **alone**, Dt 29:13-15

1 Kings 8:39 then hear in heaven Your dwelling place, and forgive, and act, and give to everyone according to all his ways, whose heart You know (for **You alone know the hearts of all the sons of men**),

2 Kings 19:15 Then Hezekiah prayed before the LORD, and said: “O LORD God of Israel, the One who dwells between the cherubim, **You are God, You alone**, of all the kingdoms of the earth. You have made heaven and earth. 2 Kings 19:14-16

2 Kings 19:19 Now therefore, O LORD our God, I pray, save us from his hand, **that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that You are the LORD God, You alone.**” 2 Kings 19:18-20

2 Chronicles 6:30 then hear from heaven Your dwelling place, and forgive, and **give to everyone according to all his ways, whose heart You know (for You alone know the hearts of the sons of men)**, 2 Chronicles 6:29-31

Nehemiah 9:6 **You alone are the LORD; You have made heaven,** The heaven of heavens, with all their host, **The earth and everything on it,** The seas and all that is in them, And You preserve them all. The host of heaven worships You. Nehemiah 9:5-7

Job 9:8 He **alone** spreads out the heavens, And treads on the waves of the sea; Job 9:7-9

Psalms 83:18 That they may know that **You, whose name alone is the LORD, are the Most High over all the earth.** Psalm 83:17-18

Psalms 86:10 For You are great, and do wondrous things; **You alone are God.** Psalm 86:9-11

Psalms 136:4 To **Him who alone does great wonders,** for His mercy endures forever; Psalm 136:3-5

Psalms 148:13 Let them praise the name of the LORD, for **His name alone is exalted;** His glory is above the earth and heaven.

Ecclesiastes 4:8 **There is one alone, without companion: He has neither son nor brother.** Yet there is no end to all his labors, Nor is his eye satisfied with riches. But he never asks, “For whom do I toil and deprive myself of good?” This also is vanity and a grave misfortune. Ecclesiastes 4:7-9

Isaiah 2:11 The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, The haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, And the LORD **alone** shall be exalted in that day. Isaiah 2:10-12

Isaiah 2:17 The loftiness of man shall be bowed down, And the haughtiness of men shall be brought low; **The LORD alone will be exalted in that day,** Isaiah 2:16-18

Isaiah 37:16 “O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, the One who dwells between the cherubim, **You are God, You alone,** of all the kingdoms of the earth. You have made heaven and earth. Isaiah 37:15-17

Isaiah 37:20 Now therefore, O LORD our God, save us from his hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that **You are the LORD, You alone.**” Isaiah 37:19-21

Isaiah 44:24 Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, and **He who formed you from the womb: “I am the LORD, who makes all things, Who stretches out the heavens all alone, Who spreads abroad the earth by Myself;** Isaiah 44:23-25

Jeremiah 49:31 “Arise, go up to the wealthy nation that dwells securely,” says the LORD, “Which has neither gates nor bars, Dwelling **alone.** Jeremiah 49:30-32

Mark 1:24 saying, “Let us **alone!** What have we to do with You, **Jesus** of Nazareth? Did You come to destroy us? **I know who You are—the Holy One of God!**” Mark 1:23-25

Mark 2:7 “Why does this Man speak blasphemies like this? **Who can forgive sins but God alone?”** Mk 2:6-8

Luke 4:34 saying, “Let us **alone!** What have we to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth? Did You come to destroy us? **I know who You are—the Holy One of God!**” Luke 4:33-35

Luke 5:21 And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, “Who is this who speaks blasphemies? **Who can forgive sins but God alone?”** Luke 5:20-22

John 8:16 And yet if I do judge, My judgment is true; for **I am not alone**, but I am with the Father who sent Me. John 8:15-17  
Romans 16:27 **to God, alone** wise, be glory through Jesus Christ forever. Amen. Romans 16:26-27  
Timothy 1:17 **Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone** is wise, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen. 1 Timothy 1:16-18  
1 Timothy 6:15-16 **the King of kings and Lord of lords, 16 who alone** has immortality, dwelling in unapproachable light, whom no man has seen or can see, to whom be honor and everlasting power. Amen.  
Jude 1:25 **To God our Savior, Who alone** is wise, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and forever. Amen. Jude 1:24-25  
Revelation 15:4 **Who shall not fear You, O Lord,** and glorify Your name? For **You alone** are holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, for Your judgments have been manifested.” Revelation 15:3-5

### Summarizing the word “Alone”

Word studies are so easy to do with computers. Each word can range from one to multi-hundreds. If you want to be well documented, you need to read every entry. then group the like one and consider every entry in the full context of the scripture verses. It is in this manner that you fulfill the intent of 2 Timothy 2:15 for studying to show yourself approved, rightfully dividing the Word of Truth.

By studying diligently, and not slanting your conclusions, you will be blessed.

The word “alone” is summarized in its use as follows:

God alone is our Redeemer, our Savior, who alone is wise and holy, to him be honor and everlasting power.

God Alone is all knowing of all things.

The Lord alone is to be exalted, whose glory is above the heavens and earth.

He alone is without companion, son, or brother.

He alone is not satisfied with riches, who has created all things, he has created us from the womb.

There alone is one eternal dwelling.

God alone forgives sin.

Jesus and God are judge.

God alone is wise, to him be glory through Jesus Christ, forever

He alone is King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone has immortality and dwells in unapproachable light, who no man has seen or can see.

This word study shows that those who dare to make God and Jesus into two separate human beings is wrong. The individual descriptive words deny that possibility. God says that he is not a man in the first place.

There are those who have made God and Christ into mans image for the purpose of becoming equals with God and Christ in some fabricated council of innumerable gods that cannot save even themselves from the condemnation to hell.

God, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit have got to be uniquely one triune godhead. If one is not congruent with the other (the same), God’s own need to be absolutely holy, with an absolutely holy redeemer, could not be met. But, second best would never be good enough for God, so the trinity doctrine taught in the *Bible* makes simple sense out of what some think of as a complex illogical doctrine.

“Alone” is a most important word study to comprehend the nature of God, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit. Spiritual blindness and pride are barriers to understanding God’s Word and one’s coming to salvation that is based upon faith and grace alone.
